Generosity Cycle

During the Generosity Cycle, we journey as a worldwide community through a season of giving. Four phases highlight the six-week cycle: Invite, Discover, Respond, and Reflect.

The Generosity Cycle begins this Sunday, October 6 and runs for 6 weeks. This week the phase that we are focusing on is "Invite." Community of Christ App and E-Tithing

Have you downloaded the Community of Christ App yet? Its easy! Just go to: <u>Install the Community of Christ App | Community of Christ International Headquarters (cofchrist.org)</u>

On the app you'll find the latest stories, videos, announcements, and the Daily Prayer for Peace for each day. You can also use your app to give through Secure Give. Giving is now even easier! Once you download the app, go to "Give" and type in your username and password if you already have an account. If you don't yet have an account click the link "Find Your Organization" and then type in Community of Christ. "My Home Congregation" can be used if you hold membership where you want to give; there are also options for "Support for Ukraine", "Bridge of Hope", "World Church" and then congregations who pay to have their own campus. This is a great option for occasional donations — for instance if visitors want to give but don't carry cash. Otherwise setting up recurring transactions are easiest, and can be set up and managed through the app.

World Conference Announcements

Change in Conference Dates

The 2023 World Conference dates are shifting by one day. Pre-conference workshops, learning opportunities, and discussion sessions will be held on Friday, April 21. The World Conference will officially begin on Saturday, April 22, with the opening legislative session at 10 am. The conference will end on Friday, April 28, at the close of the afternoon legislative session and sending forth worship. This schedule change allows people at conference to participate more fully in Graceland University's commencement activities which begin Friday evening, April 28 and end Sunday, April 30.

Remote Sites for World Conference

An exploratory team, led by Wim van Klinken, researched numerous remote site options for the World Conference. After extensive study and testing, they returned their findings to the World Church Leadership Council. Based on those findings as well as the complexity of technology and budget limitations, the Council of Twelve has tentatively determined two locations for remote sites. One will be hosted in Honduras and the other will be hosted in D.R. Congo. One additional remote location will be hosted at Graceland University to accommodate students who are taking their final exams during World Conference week.

Protocol for COVID

Special attention is being given to health and safety. This will require some precautions not experienced at conference before. Based on what we know at this time, people will be strongly encouraged to wear masks when indoors at World Conference to protect the most vulnerable in our gathering. We will provide larger spaces for delegation seating using the main floor and the balcony and encourage people to spread out during other indoor events. We are also strongly encouraging participants to take several self-initiated and self-monitored precautions to include testing for COVID before arriving, staying home if one tests positive or has fever or symptoms, and getting up-to-date on vaccinations to protect one's self.
