HealthEd Connect Role, by Chris Davisdon

This past May I began working full-time for HealthEd Connect as the International Programs Manager. HealthEd Connect is a nonprofit organization founded by Jac and Sherri Kirkpatrick whose mission is to "empower women and children through evidence-based health, education, and advocacy programs." We accomplish this mission in partnership with 174 volunteer community health workers (CHWs), across 60 communities in Zambia, Malawi, the Democratic Republic of Congo and Nepal. These dedicated volunteers are equipped to provide basic care using WHO guidelines through community home visits, providing under 5 clinics and community

health educational opportunities. In Zambia we also support access to education for orphans and vulnerable children through sponsoring 3 community schools. As the International programs manager I get to work with our local site partners and support the programs that our volunteers provide.

While I just started working full-time with HealthEd Connect, Matt and I have been supporters of the organization for a very long time. When we lived in Malawi with World Service Corps, we worked with the health workers there as part of the work we were doing. So the mission of HealthEd Connect is not new to me. Working in this new position is an exciting opportunity to support this organization in a new way.

At the end of August and first part of September I made my first HealthEd Connect trip to Africa, traveling with Emily Penrose-McLaughlin, who is the Executive Director. We spent 1 week in Malawi and 2 weeks in Zambia, meeting with almost all of our volunteers in those locations. The first week in Malawi was such a wonderful homecoming since Matt and I had lived there almost 25 years ago! I knew many of the volunteers from our time there, and a surprising number of them remembered

me as well! It was so good to be able to visit all our centers where our volunteers weigh hundreds of babies each month in Under 5 clinics, ensuring a healthy start for babies in a country where malnutrition and stunted growth is a major concern.

Traveling to Zambia, it was wonderful to meet our volunteers in all the locations there! We traveled to the Luapula district, as well as the "Copperbelt" area with 3 locations in Chingola, Kitwe and Ndola. While in Luapula, we also met with our volunteers from the DRC. Emily and I were unable to get a visa to travel to the DRC, so they came across the river to visit us in Zambia. It was wonderful to not only meet our site partners but to participate in trainings alongside them as well.

In the Copperbelt, in addition to our volunteer health workers, we also have 3 community primary schools. In all the locations we received such a warm welcome, but at each of the schools we had programs with all the school children in addition to visiting each and every classroom! The energy on those days was palpable as they danced and sang and shared with us!

It was such a gift to be able to travel and see our programs in action and meet the people who are the heart of our organization and who give of their time and energy to bring hope and healing in their communities!




