





Offering Sanctuary

Community of Christ has been asked by many congregations in the United States how they can respond to immigration issues—offering church buildings or facilities as sanctuaries, and/or how to generally participate in the sanctuary movement.

Congregations and members seeking guidance about how they can respond to immigration issues should start by reviewing the information and recommended actions in the 2013 Statement on Immigration, available in the Official Statements on Our Ministry Tools. (Immigration-Statement-English.pdf)

Earlier this week, Karen Hill emailed 3 guides provided by the Office of General Counsel of Community of Christ:

- 1. Offering Sanctuary—Informational Guidance for U.S. Community of Christ Leaders
- 2. Sanctuary in the U.S. —General Legal Overview
- 3. **Immigration Enforcement Actions—Action Plan for Congregations**, which includes very specific guidance in these 2 sections:
 - ⇒ BE PREPARED
 - ⇒ WHAT TO DO IF ICE OR OTHER LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS SHOW UP AT CHURCH

What is the most common response received thus far in the interviews to question 4,

Q: What do you think is important for the Community of Christ to do now?

A: Many people, especially those that are home-bound, <u>would love to have people</u> <u>from church visit periodically</u>. This need has come up in many of the interviews.

Visiting is already occurring, but this feedback reminds everyone, that there is the need for more connection. Whether a priesthood member or not, we can experience the **Blessings of Community** when we spend time visiting.

Karen and Liz have asked the Cluster Leaders, as they reach out to pastors each month, to encourage each congregation to maintain 2 lists to support visiting:

- 1. Those that would like periodic home visits
- 2. Those that would be able to join with another member and go visiting.

Maintaining the lists can help promote more active visiting. Just a reminder that it is best practice that a pair (or more) of people do the home visit together.

- 2. What was your first interaction with this church?
- 3. Can you share 1 or 2 special testimonies of God's influence or blessings on your life?
- 4. What do you think is important for the Community of Christ to do now?
- 5. How do you think we can share the gospel with others?
- 6. Who was/is the most influential person from this church in your life/why?
- 7. What is the most important thing you want others to know about you?
